Gerold is a co-editor of the Austrian Yearbook on International Arbitration, a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (FCIArb) and a former president of the Austrian Arbitration Association (ArbAUT). His published work includes a comprehensive commentary on Austrian arbitration law (Schiedsverfahren, 2nd edition, 2014), and more recently co-authored the Austrian chapter in Balthasar (ed.), International Commercial Arbitration: A Handbook, 2nd Edition. He regularly speaks at international conferences, recently at ICC Austria's Arbitration and Dispute Settlement Seminars on "Revision ICC Arbitration Rules", and guest lectures a university course at Graz University.
